Annual Intake for Admissions into DMIT Course:-

DMIT Course - Government Quota – 2 Seats & Management Quota – 2 Seats

Application forms are inviting for each academic year from the eligible candidates for admission into DMIT Course without Entrance Test for the Government Quota Seats in Colleges recognized by the Andhra Pradesh Para Medical Board, Hyderabad. The Syllabus of the Course & Instructions for filling application form is also available on the Website <http://appmb.org.in>

Eligibility for Admissions:-

Minimum educational qualification is Intermediate with Science Group (Bi.P.C.) as entry qualification for admission as may be notified by the Government from time to time. If adequate students of Bi.P.C. are not available, students with Intermediate Maths, Physics and Chemistry (M.P.C.) will be considered and if adequate students with M.P.C. are not available, students with Intermediate with other subjects can be considered and should have completed 16 Years of Age as on the date fixed by the University for each academic year.

Candidates qualified 10+2 level of Education in India or Abroad OR in other Boards other than Board of Intermediate Education, A.P., Hyderabad, should take Eligibility / Equivalency Certificate from the Board of Intermediate Education, A.P., Hyderabad. Candidates requiring Equivalency Certificate be directed to address the Secretary, Board of Intermediate Education, A.P., Nampally, Hyderabad.

Duration of the Course:-

The duration of certified study for the DMIT course shall be Two (2) academic years.

Medium of Instruction:-

English will be the medium of instruction for the subjects of study and for the examinations of the DMIT course. The text book language for all the subjects of the DMIT course is also English.

Attendance:-

A candidate is required to put in a minimum of 85% of attendance in both theory and practicals separately in each subject before appearing for the Examination.
